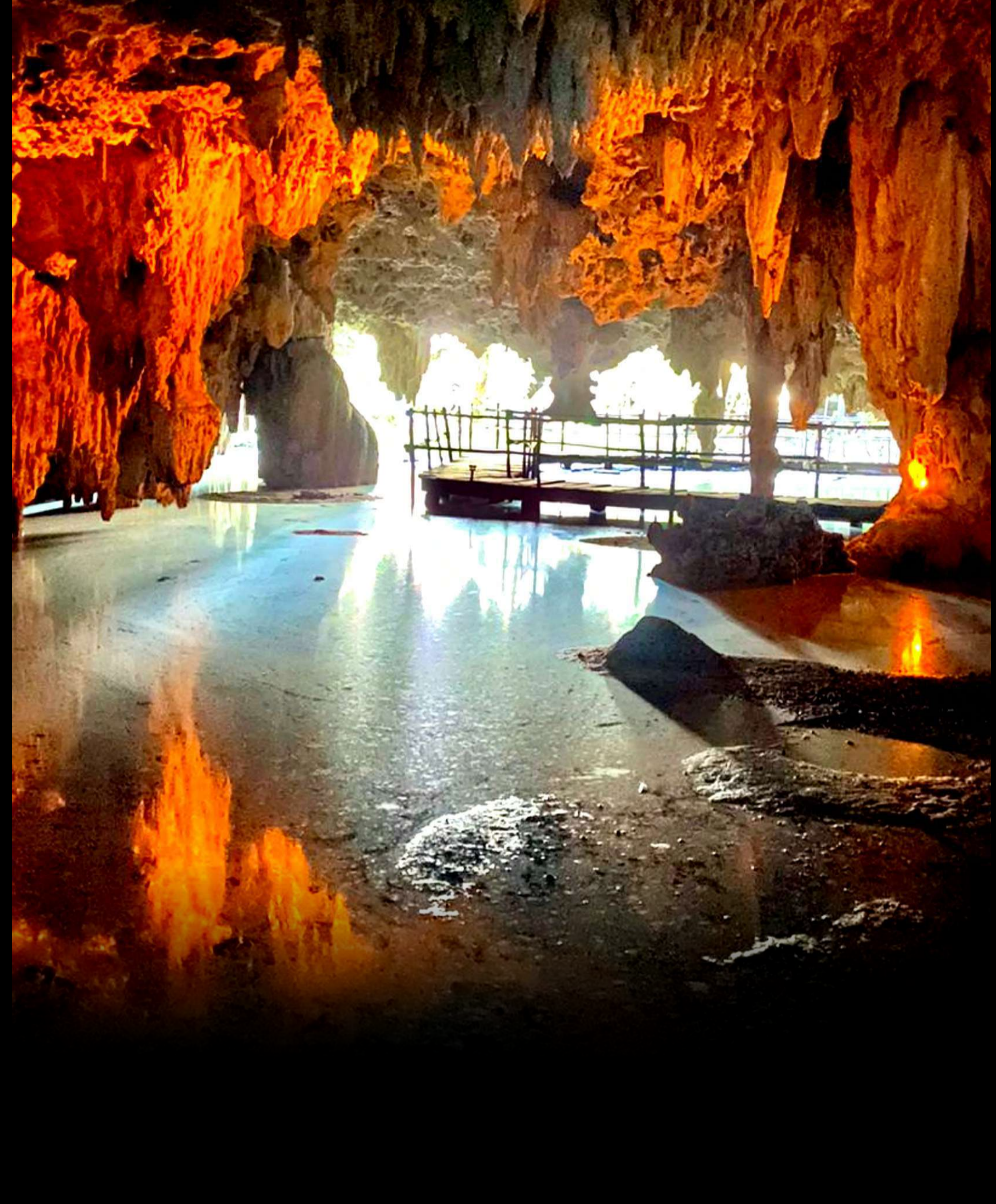


# CAVES & CAVERNS

The first part of the tour, it's a walk through a magnificent dry grotto.

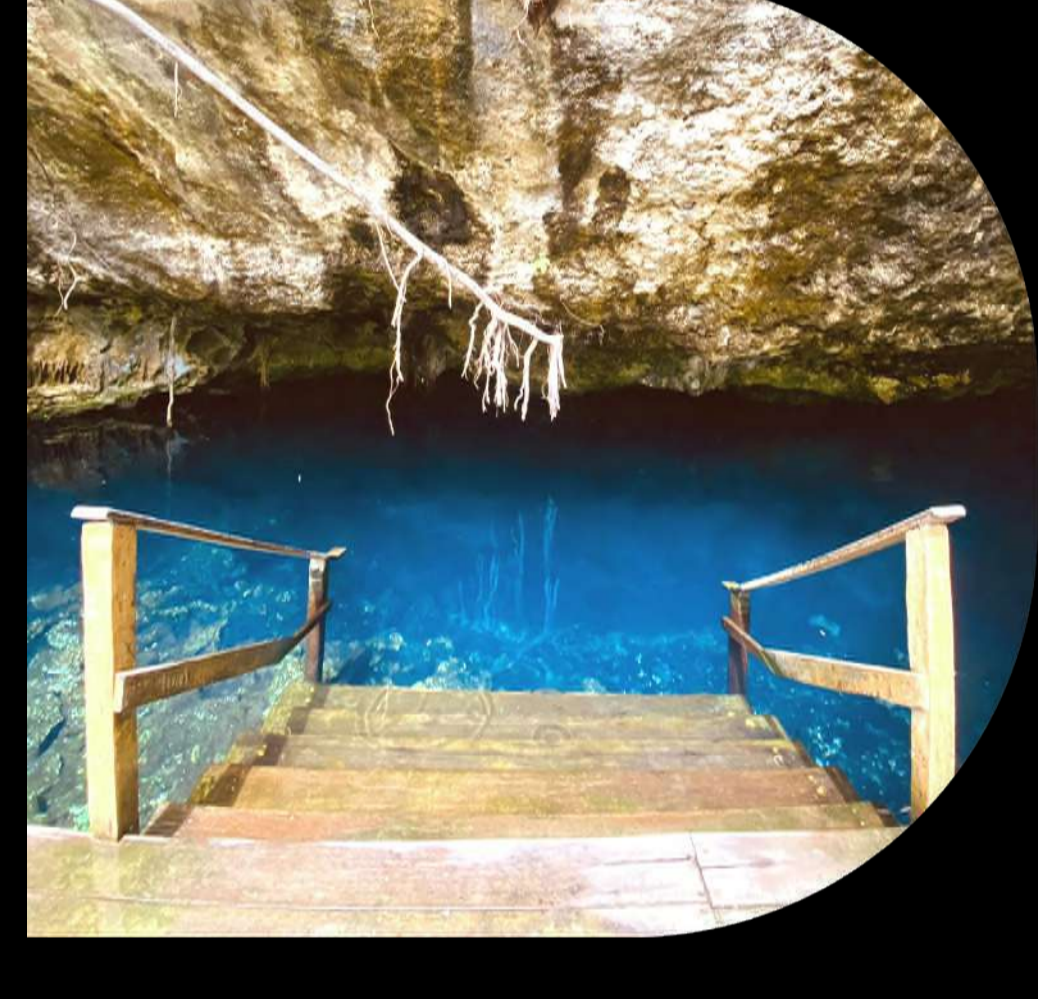
Set with colored lights, you will experience an incredible atmosphere.

You don't have to worry if you want to avoid the previous activities, because there is a stairway leading down from the surface.

Either way, after getting into the water, we'll snorkel inside the cavern to watch stalactites and stalagmites.

For the second location, a beautiful open cenote with bright colors will delight your eyes while you're swimming under the sunshine.

On our way back, the last stop is Downtown. It is time to taste some of the best local food in the region before the drop-off.

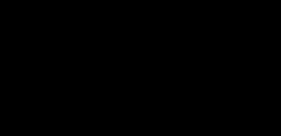

This tour is like no other!



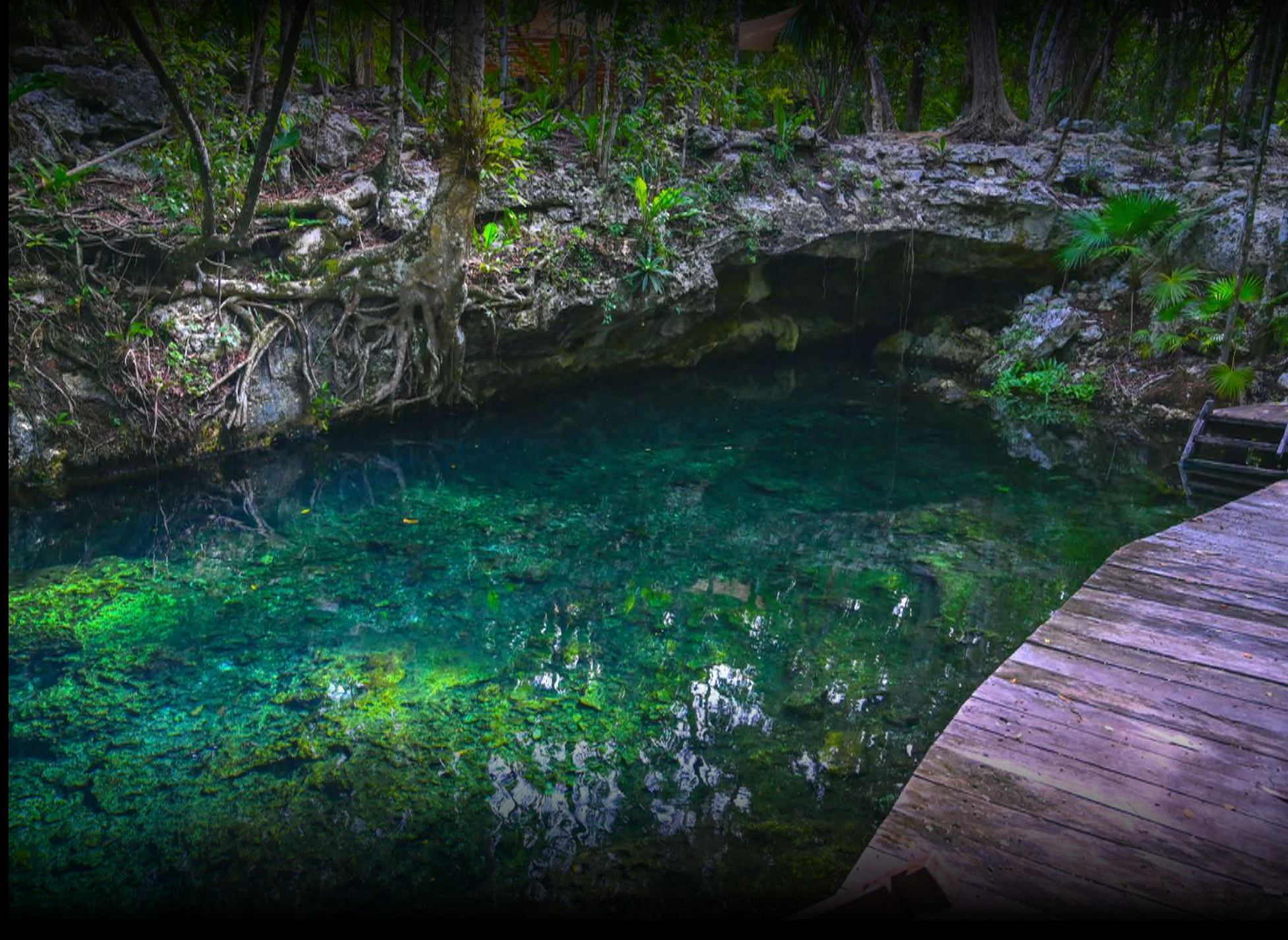
We'll do a little trip to a beautiful open cenote directly connected to the sea.

Welcome to the majestic Tulum Ruins.



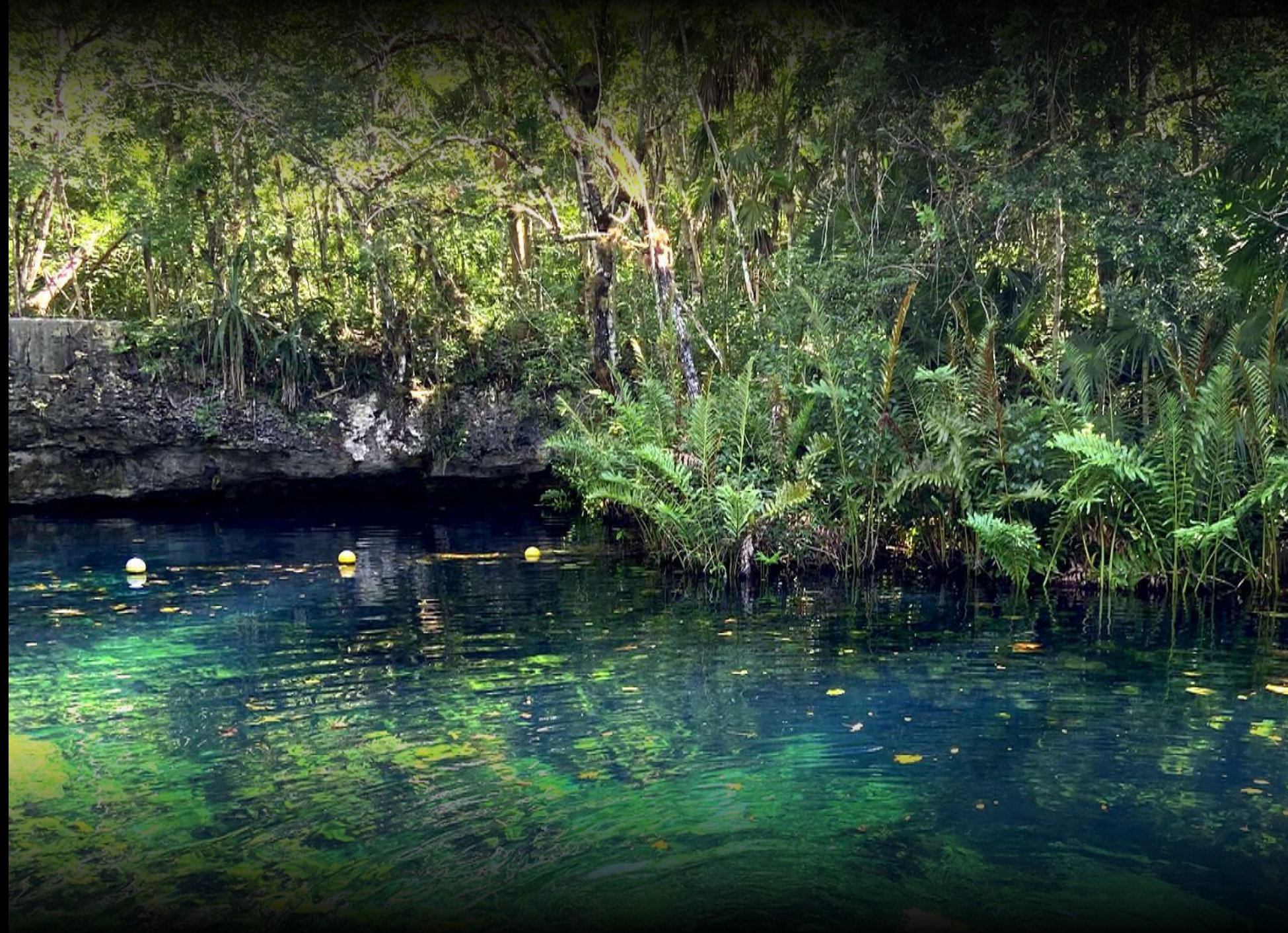
One of the most important Mayan cities was built on a cliff next to the Mexican Caribbean, all dedicated to the sunrise.

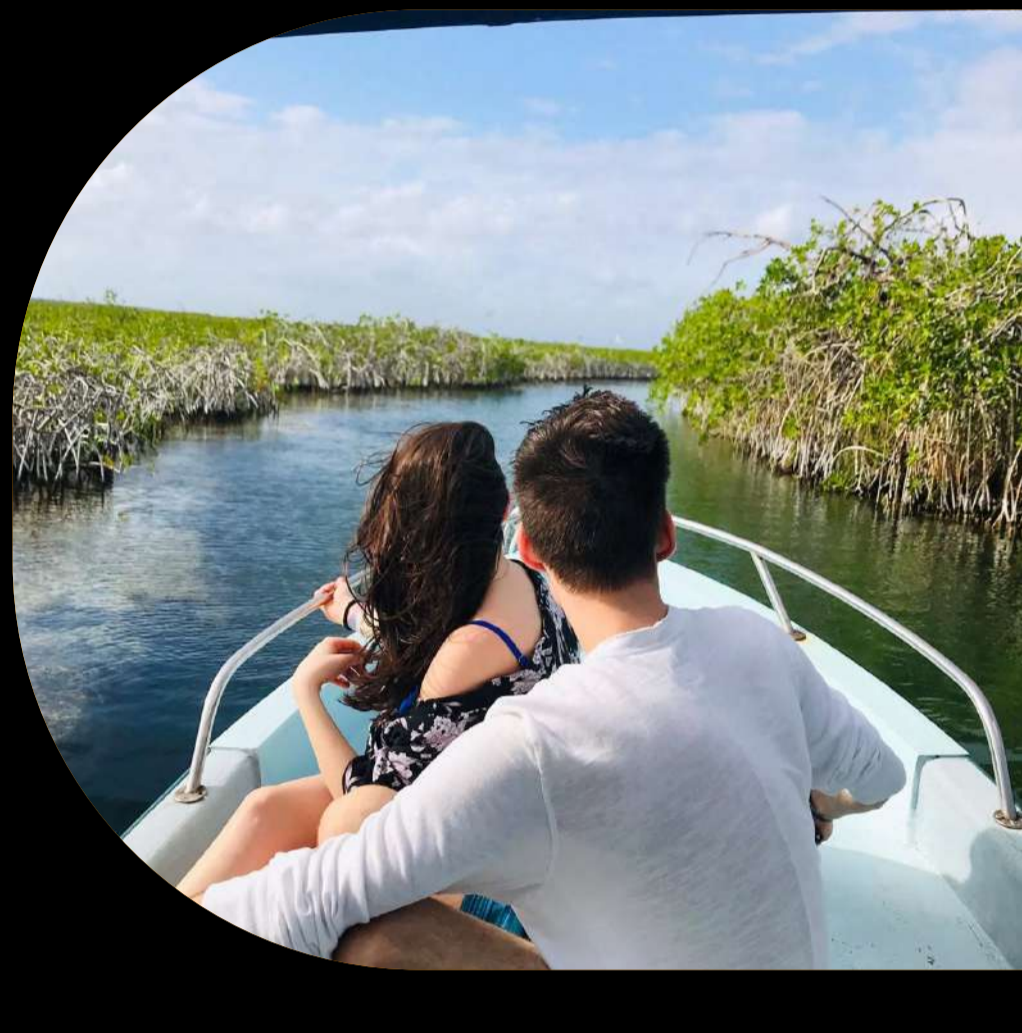
# SIAN KA'AN

We'll attempt to find some crocodiles too.



Navigating through ancient canals that were used as trade routes by the mayan people, we'll find two old temples as proof of this.

Since this incredible place connects directly with the sea, we'll make a stop at the Bocapaila pristine beach.

Then, the skipper will take us back to the canals to reach a wooden path that leads to the point where we finally will enjoy an almost effortless downstream flotation with the help of a life jacket.

You will admire beautiful landscapes, and if you want, you can rub natural mud over your skin.

## TEMAZCAL CEREMONY



### Experience

A temazcal (from the Nahuatl temazcalli, house where you sweat) refers to an ancestral ritual and a steam bath with herbal infusions.



Used in traditional medicine for detoxification purposes and the daily life of the people from several indigenous cultures in Mesoamerica and North America.

It all starts in the middle of the jungle, with an opening ceremony in front of the village altar. This takes place in front of a fire, where you expose your intentions to this element as an offering.

Now, it is time to get inside the temazcal and to go on with this mayan purification.

At the end of the ceremony, we'll take you to a private cenote to immerse yourself in mineralized waters and close the cycle of energies and blessings. Here you will also enjoy a tasting of seasonal fruits.

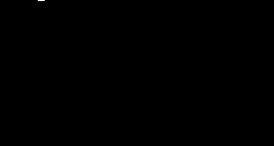
